BOATS 14' OR OVER ~ DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

1. Bill of sale
2. Title or Coast Guard documentation papers from the previous owner
3. Sales tax form (ST6)
4. Pencil tracing of hull ID number (necessary when applying by mail)
5. Required fees ~ \$30 registration valid for two years, \$15 title fee one time fee.

If boat is brand new, purchased from a registered boat dealer or department store, an original "Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin" is required in lieu of title.

When a boat is purchased from a private party, from a non-titled state, the previous owner's registration is required in lieu of title.

BOATS UNDER 14' ~ DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

1. Bill of sale
2. Sales tax form (ST6)
3. Pencil tracing of hull ID number (necessary when applying by mail)
4. Required fee ~ \$30 registration valid for two years

If a new boat is purchased from a registered boat dealer or department store, a copy of the "Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin" is required.

ATV/SNOW ~ DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

1. Bill of sale
2. Sales tax form (ST6)
3. Serial number (ATV – 17 characters, Polaris ATV vehicles have only 6 characters)
4. Required fee ~ \$30 - Massachusetts Resident valid for two years
\$20 – Non-resident valid for one year

If ATV or snowmobile is purchased brand new, a copy of the "Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin" is required.

- *Please write separate checks for (1) registration/title and (2) sales tax. Checks are made payable to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.*
- *Please also note: Sales tax is due on the 20th day of the following month from date of purchase. If the sales tax is late; you need to contact the Dept. of Revenue at 508-678-2844 to figure your tax before mailing the application forms into the registration office.*
